Had Fab Supports Flagship Edinburgh Tram Project with Turnkey Delivery of Overhead Line Poles



Project Summary

The Edinburgh Tram Project has been under construction since November 2019 and involves a 2.9 mile route extension to the city's tram system. Funded by the Scottish Government, the project has seen the return of trams to Leith Walk for the first time since 1956. As part of this project Had Fab was requested to deliver 144 overhead line poles as part of a tight project delivery schedule and to a clearly defined budget.

Challenge

To deliver a complete turnkey offering for the flagship Edinburgh Tram Project providing a full service from procurement and fabrication through to the painting and delivery of 144 overhead line poles.

The Solution

- Successful project delivery on one of Scotland's most iconic rail projects

- The successful integration of all steelwork delivered in line with exacting project requirements

Key Achievements

- The £207m extension was successfully launched this year and will see trams run from Picardy Place to Newhaven
- Full collaboration with all third parties to co-ordinate a number of project elements and distinct deadlines
- The delivery of 144 procured, fabricated and installed overhead line poles on time, on budget and to specification
- The solidifying of Had Fab's position as a market leading fabricator to the rail industry.
